Directions

- Step 1** Read the Student Handbook. It can be found online at www.ambex-germany.org under “Apply Online.” You will be asked to certify with your signature that you have read and understood it, and that you will strive to abide by the letter and intent therein.
- Step 2** Give the Christian Leader Referral to an appropriate pastor, church leader/teacher, or deacon. Have him or her complete the form, and mail it in right away.
- Step 3** Complete the Application for Admission. Register for classes you desire to attend by marking courses listed on the calendar and collect the required signatures.
- Step 4** Complete essays, each between 250-300 words in length. Essays must be typed and submitted with your application.
- Step 5** Have your Faculty Advisor and/or College Registrar approve your participation and sign the application.
